

## Fishing regulations

Dec 2024

- Use of dam and surrounding area is at own risk.
- Users accept rules and legal terms and conditions excluding liability.
- Use of the dam and surrounding area is for the residents of Aan de Weber Estate only.
- Users accept all risks, as the dam is a farm dam, with uneven terrain and non-potable water.
- Minors must always be under direct adult supervision.
- No access to the dam area is permitted before sunrise, and after sunset.
- No swimming or entering the water is permitted.
- No screaming or shouting in the dam surrounding area is permitted.
- Fishing is strictly on a catch and release basis.
- Please ensure that you familiarise yourself with current fishing restrictions by scanning the QR code below, or visit [www.aandeweber.com](http://www.aandeweber.com).
- Users, including parents and/or guardians on behalf of minors, agree that they and/or the minors, indemnify Aan de Weber HOA and its employees, agents, or contractors, against any claim as a result of the use of and or entry to the dam area.

### Kind fishing

- Minimise the time a fish is out of the water.
- Only handle fish with wet hands.
- When photographing fishes, have the camera ready for use, keep the fish as close to the ground as possible, either over the water or unhooking mat and minimise the time taken to photograph it.
- Deep-hooked fish should survive if the hook cannot be removed. Here cut the line as close to the hook as possible.
- When releasing fishes, support them in open water until they are ready to swim off.
- Respect your catch, never drop or throw fish back into the water.
